BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the  
Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall budget all funds in the  
following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law shall be set by the  
Executive Director of the Commission. The salary of the Executive  
Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall not exceed  
\_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the

fiscal year ending June 30, 2000. The Oklahoma Conservation Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.
