An Act relating to solid waste; prohibiting certain solid waste services outside certain areas; providing exception for certain contracts; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 366 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

County solid waste authorities and public trusts which have one or more counties as beneficiaries and who provide solid waste collection and disposal services which protect the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the county or beneficiary, shall not provide solid waste services outside the county or the political limits of the beneficiary. Provided, however, any contractual arrangements which were in effect prior to the effective date of this act shall remain in full force and effect and may be eligible for renewal.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
