BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5031.1 of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall provide three
prescription medications per month for persons who qualify for the
Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) Program.

B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is hereby directed to
amend the State Medicaid Program to include the cost of the
allowable prescription medications.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
