BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Vocational and Technical Education by law shall be set by the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education. The salary of the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Vocational and Technical Education shall not exceed

_____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000. The Oklahoma Department of

Vocational and Technical Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
