BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-141.1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each school district shall provide with each paycheck issued to an employee an explanatory statement detailing amounts for the following:

1. Base salary, extra duty pay, any additional compensation, and a subtotal of gross compensation;

2. Pre-tax deductions for state retirement system, deferred compensation, health insurance, dental insurance, vision insurance, other similar deductions, a subtotal of pre-tax deductions;

3. Adjusted gross compensation arrived at by subtracting pre-tax deductions from gross compensation;

4. Payroll tax deductions for federal income tax withheld, state income tax withheld, FICA (social security), Medicare, other similar deductions;

5. Any other deductions; and

6. The net amount of the paycheck.

B. Nothing herein shall preclude a school district from providing more information to employees than is required in this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
