[ tourism and recreation - hazardous pay for park  
rangers - codification - effective date -  
emergency ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1811.9 of Title 74, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Effective July 1, 1999, the salaries for positions of Park  
Ranger I, II, and III shall be increased by five percent (5%). This  
amount is made to compensate such employees for hazardous duty.  
Current employees in the positions of Park Ranger I, II, and III  
shall receive this increase to compensation beginning July 1, 1999.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
