BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1411.3 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Developmental Disabilities Services Division of the Department of Human Services shall implement a program to provide services at the Northern Oklahoma Resource Center of Enid and the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center at Pauls Valley for developmentally disabled clients in community placements. Such services may include, but need not be limited to:

1. Daily living support skills and training;
2. Employment services;
3. Professional therapies;
4. Nursing services;
5. Dental services;
6. Nutritional and dietary counseling;
7. Transportation services;
8. Training of direct care staff for private providers;
9. Family member training and support services; and
10. Pharmaceutical services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
