An Act relating to cosmetology; exempting persons performing fashion photography from licensing by State Board of Cosmetology; defining term; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 199.18 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Persons performing and businesses primarily providing fashion photography services shall be exempt from the terms and provisions of Section 199.1 et seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes and from licensing requirements imposed thereunder.

B. For the purposes of this section, "fashion photography" means the application of a cosmetic makeover and styling session followed by a photography session for which the photographs are offered for sale to the subject.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
