

ENGROSSED SENATE

An Act relating to the Department of Labor;
authorizing certain petty cash fund pursuant to
certain rules and procedures; stating purpose of
fund; providing for codification; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 141.20 of Title 40, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Director of State Finance is hereby authorized, upon
request by the Commissioner of Labor, to establish a petty cash fund
for the Department of Labor in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred
Dollars (\$400.00), to be used for the purpose of making change for
persons obtaining licenses and transacting other such business with
the Department.

B. The fund shall be established and replenished from any
monies available to the Department for operating expenses.

C. The Director of State Finance shall prescribe all forms,
systems, and procedures for administering the fund.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
