

ENGROSSED SENATE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Legislature hereby finds that access to air
transportation is fundamental to the future economic development of
this state and to the enhancement of the quality of life for all
citizens, corporate and otherwise.

B. It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature to take such
legislative action as it deems necessary and expedient to provide an
atmosphere conducive to the attraction of new air transportation
companies and facilities to this state and the retention and
expansion of existing air transportation companies and facilities,
including, but not limited to, the construction and maintenance of
needed infrastructure and the provision of economic incentives.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
