[schools - authorizing teachers to promote certain
students - codification - effective date -
emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.508E of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A teacher who determines a third grade student is unable to meet
competencies required for completion of third grade and promotion to
fourth grade, shall have the authority to promote the student,
contingent upon the student's successful completion and mastery of
the required competencies at a summer academy. Summer academy
programs shall be designed to ensure the student masters
requirements necessary for promotion to fourth grade and shall
enhance next grade readiness.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
