BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 193, O.S.L. 1996, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 369, O.S.L. 1999 (62 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 2004), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2004. The monies appropriated to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund shall be subject to all of the requirements of Sections 2006 through 2013 of this title. There shall be deposited into each of the accounts provided by Section 2006 of this title the sum of one-tenth (1/10) of the amount appropriated to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund with the exception of one account which shall be divided equally into two (2) subaccounts. One of the ~~two~~ subaccounts shall be available to one and only one of the entities described by subsection B of Section 2007 of this title for distribution to cities or towns within the respective jurisdiction of the entity if the population of such city or town does not exceed seven thousand (7,000) persons according to the latest Federal Decennial Census or for the benefit of an unincorporated area. However, funds may also be expended for cities or towns with a population below seven thousand (7,000) persons based upon the current population estimate according to the U.S. Census Bureau.

Funds may be expended for those cities and towns until the next Federal Decennial Census subsequent to the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
