An Act relating to the Supreme Court and the State Fire Marshal; amending Section 11, Chapter 382, O.S.L. 1998, which relates to budgetary limitations of the Supreme Court; modifying certain budgetary limitations; amending Section 10, Chapter 241, O.S.L. 1998, which relates to budgetary limitations of the State Fire Marshal; modifying certain budgetary limitations; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 382, O.S.L. 1998, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the State Supreme Court shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 10, Chapter 241, O.S.L. 1998, is amended to read as follows:

Section 10. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the State Fire Marshall shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:
