An Act relating to public health and safety;  
providing legislative intent; requiring certain  
senior citizens to receive certain amount of  
prescription medications; providing for certain  
services; providing for codification; and providing  
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5009.3 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall provide Medicaid  
services for persons who meet the income standards of the Qualified  
Medicare Beneficiary (QMB) Program.

B. It is the intent of the Legislature that senior citizens who  
meet the income standards of the Qualified Medicare Beneficiary  
(QMB) Program receive three prescription medications to improve  
their quality of life.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
