An Act relating to poor persons; authorizing certain promulgation of rules under certain conditions; providing for extension of coverage for certain recipients for certain length of time; stating legislative intent concerning SoonerCare Plus; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules that will, as funds become available, extend coverage for twelve (12) months for guaranteed health care services to eligible Medicaid recipients.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that additional appropriated funds for health plans participating in SoonerCare Plus be reflected in increased rates for network providers.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
