An Act relating to veterans; authorizing certain divisions of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs under certain conditions to be regarded as an individual purchasing entity; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 221.5 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

For the determination of compliance with limits set forth in the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act, each division of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs that operates a Veterans Center shall, if the division has a Certified Procurement Officer and makes purchases in compliance with internal purchasing procedures of the Department of Veterans Affairs that are approved by the Department of Central Services, be regarded as an individual purchasing entity.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
