An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
designating the Clara Luper Corridor; requiring  
Department of Transportation to place markers;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1636 of Title 69, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 107, starting at the intersection of State Highway  
107 and Interstate 235 extending approximately two and one-half  
(2.5) miles to the intersection of State Highway 107 and Interstate  
35 shall be designated as the "Clara Luper Corridor". The Oklahoma  
Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
to be placed upon the highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
