An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
designating a portion of State Highway 18 in Osage  
County as the "Marjorie and Maria Tallchief Highway";  
designating a portion of State Highway 18 in Osage  
County as the "Senator Frank Mahan Highway";  
requiring the Department of Transportation to cause  
suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the  
highway bearing said name; providing for  
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1640 of Title 69, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 18 northbound from Fairfax, Oklahoma, to where it  
intersects with State Highway 60 in Osage County shall be designated  
"Marjorie and Maria Tallchief Highway". The Department of  
Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed  
upon the highway bearing said name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1641 of Title 69, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 18 southbound from Fairfax, Oklahoma, to where it  
intersects with State Highway 20 in Osage County shall be designated  
"Senator Frank Mahan Highway". The Department of Transportation  
shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway  
bearing said name.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
