An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
prohibiting the Department of Transportation and the
Oklahoma Transportation Authority from soliciting or
entering into certain agreement; defining term;
providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1911 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Transportation and the Oklahoma Transportation
Authority shall not solicit or enter into any agreement for routine
maintenance of any road, bridge, highway or turnpike which is
currently being performed by Authority or Department employees.

For the purposes of this section, "routine maintenance" includes
but is not limited to mowing, litter or snow removal, fencing,
guardrail replacement or the overlay or replacement of surface
material.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
