An Act relating to the State Fire Marshal; amending Section 10, Chapter 241, O.S.L. 1998, as amended by Section 2 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1548 of the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to budgetary limitations of the State Fire Marshal; modifying certain budgetary limitations; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 10, Chapter 241, O.S.L. 1998, as amended by Section 2 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1548 of the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the State Fire Marshal shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
