An Act relating to the Office of the State Treasurer;
amending Section 9 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 128 of
the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature,
which relates to budgetary requirements; modifying
budget limits; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9 of Enrolled Senate Bill
No. 128 of the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 9. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the Office
of the State Treasurer shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:
