An Act relating to the Department of Corrections;
making an appropriation; stating purpose; providing
an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Seven Million One Hundred Ninety-six Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$7,196,775.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to enhance the Department of Corrections' ability to provide efficient and effective quality medical services as outlined by the Medical Consultant Report issued in July of 1998 by Dr. Greifinger to the Department of Corrections. The funding in this section shall be in addition to the current year budget for medical services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
