An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain bridge as the "Victor Wickersham Memorial Bridge"; requiring the Department of Transportation to place certain markings on certain bridge; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1631 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge across the north fork of the Red River, between the Greer and Kiowa county line on State Highway 44 shall be known as the "Victor Wickersham Memorial Bridge", and the Department of Transportation shall cause it to be appropriately marked to memorialize the services and contributions of the Honorable Representative Victor Wickersham.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
