An Act relating to the Legislative Service Bureau; amending Section 56 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2260 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature which relates to appropriations to the Legislative Service Bureau; modifying appropriation; making appropriations to the Legislative Service Bureau; stating purposes; amending Section 57 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2260 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature; which relates to appropriations; modifying appropriation; making an appropriation to the Legislative Service Bureau for the purpose of funding the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center; making certain appropriations nonfiscal; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; requiring certain budgeting procedures; providing lapse dates; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 56 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2260 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 56. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of ~~One Million Five Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-nine Dollars (\$1,557,899.00)~~ One Million Forty Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-four Dollars (\$1,040,254.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of Five Hundred Two Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$502,460.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary

to perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 57 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2260 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as follows:

Section 57. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of ~~Six Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-four Dollars (\$629,394.00)~~ Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$644,579.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund the operations of the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of Thirty-four Thousand Dollars (\$34,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund the operations of the Oklahoma Criminal Justice Resource Center.

SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001 (hereafter FY-01), or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002 (hereafter FY-02). Funds budgeted for FY-01 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2001, and must be expended by November 15, 2001. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2001, and not budgeted for FY-02, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-02 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2002. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2002, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-01, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-02, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budgeted work program revision removing these funds from the FY-01 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
