An Act relating to cultural development and technology entities; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Arts Council; stating purpose; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Chief Administrative Officer; providing budgetary limitations; requiring transfer of certain funds; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority; stating purpose; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology; stating purpose; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measure; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; requiring certain funds to be deposited in certain revolving fund; making certain appropriations nonfiscal; requiring budgeting of certain funds in certain years; requiring certain budgeting procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing lapse dates; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA ARTS COUNCIL

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Arts Council, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Arts Council by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the Oklahoma Arts Council shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council. The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed Fifty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$52,500.00) per annum, payable monthly for the months of July, August and September 2000. Effective October 1 the salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed Fifty-four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$54,500.00) for the remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001. The Oklahoma Arts Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2260 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature and Section 1 of this act, the agency shall transfer Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) from Community Programs to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department for Red Earth.

OKLAHOMA EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION AUTHORITY

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of One Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$182,800.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law.

SECTION 6. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 7. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-seven Thousand One Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$57,116.00) per annum, payable monthly for the months of July, August, and September 2000. Effective October 1, 2000, the salary of the Director shall not exceed Fifty-nine Thousand One Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$59,116.00) per annum, payable monthly for the remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001. The Oklahoma Educational Television Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

OKLAHOMA CENTER FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

SECTION 8. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Center for Advancement of Science and Technology by law.

SECTION 9. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-01 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 12. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 13. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
