A Concurrent Resolution directing certain state agencies to work together to mark and maintain graves at Eastern State Hospital; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Eastern State Hospital has been providing mental health services to citizens of the State of Oklahoma since 1913; and

WHEREAS, since that time a number of persons who died while confined at Eastern State Hospital have been buried on the hospital grounds; and

WHEREAS, due to a lack of funding, the graves of those desolate and friendless individuals have not been properly maintained or marked; and

WHEREAS, the future existence of Eastern State Hospital and the ability of that institution to maintain records regarding these unmarked graves is currently in peril.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT it is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that, on or before January 1, 2000, the Department of Corrections work with the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to provide inmate labor to provide markers and maintenance for the graves of those individuals buried on the grounds of Eastern State Hospital.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services and the Director of the Department of Corrections.
