A Resolution congratulating the Yale "Bulldogs" high school boys' basketball team upon winning its first Class 2A State Championship; honoring coach David Page for being named as the 1999 high school basketball Coach of the Year; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Yale "Bulldogs" boys' high school basketball team compiled a record of 20 wins and 2 losses during its regular season, losing its two games by one-point and four-point margins; and

WHEREAS, the basketball team won its seven playoff games by an average of 21 points; and

WHEREAS, the Bulldogs basketball players won their three games at the state tournament by margins of more than 20 points in each game for a final compilation of 230 points for the Bulldogs and 157 for their opponents in the state tournament; and

WHEREAS, the Daily Oklahoman selected Troy Elliott as the Class 2A All-Tournament Team Most Valuable Player, Hank Dooley and Nick Thomas were chosen as members of the first team and Brady Page was named to the second team; and

WHEREAS, the Tulsa World's selections for the Class 2A All-Tournament Team included Troy Elliott as Most Valuable Player, Hank Dooley as a member of the first team, and Nick Thomas and Brady Page as members of the second team; and

WHEREAS, Yale High School boys' basketball coach David Page was honored as the Tulsa World's 1999 high school basketball Coach of the Year; and

WHEREAS, the Yale Bulldogs high school boys' basketball team won its first Class 2A State Championship.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
