WHEREAS, the boys' basketball team, the Mustangs, from Frontier High School in Red Rock, Oklahoma, boasts a 25-win against 4-loss record in the Class B division; and

WHEREAS, ranked first in their division, the Mustangs won the Class B state tournament, edging out second-ranked Boynton-Moton 68-67 in the second semifinal game before winning the state Class B tournament with a victory over Forgan; and

WHEREAS, this is the third state championship in four years for the Mustangs and won their first championship at the Class B level. They reached the semifinals in the year they did not win the championship; and

WHEREAS, Frontier High School boys basketball coach Bob Weckstein has coached at Frontier for 10 years. He was named the 1998-99 coach of the year by the Daily Oklahoman.
