RESOLUTION NO. 40

A Resolution requesting the Oklahoma Space Industry Authority to designate Oklahoma astronauts as honorary members; providing they shall receive no compensation nor duties; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, through the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Act (Enrolled Senate Bill No. 720), created the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Kirkpatrick Science and Air Space Museum at the Omniplex in Oklahoma City lists seven Oklahomans as astronauts; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Senate wants to recognize the contributions made by Oklahoma astronauts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate requests that the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority designate all Oklahoma astronauts as honorary members of the Authority.

THAT the Oklahoma astronauts so named shall receive no compensation nor any tasks, duties, or obligations.

THAT a copy of this resolution shall be distributed to the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority and the Kirkpatrick Science and Air Space Museum.
