RESOLUTION NO. 49

A Resolution recognizing the Stillwater High School Varsity Cheerleaders for their athletic and academic achievements; welcoming the Stillwater High School Varsity Cheerleaders and their coach to the Oklahoma State Capitol; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Stillwater High School Varsity Cheerleaders competed in San Antonio, Texas, at the American Cheerleaders Association National Competition on January 22 and 23, 2000. The squad competed against 17 other cheerleader squads from throughout the nation and won the national title by 15 points; and

WHEREAS, the Stillwater High School Varsity Cheerleaders won a national title from the American Cheerleaders Association. This is the first time Stillwater High School has received this national title; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association (OSSAA) recognized and awarded the Stillwater High School Varsity Cheerleaders the Distinguished Academic Achievement Award. The combined grade point average of the 15-member cheerleader squad is 3.56 on a 4.0 scale. This is also the first time they have received this honor; and

WHEREAS, the Varsity Cheerleaders of Stillwater High School competed at regionals and advanced to state for the first time before winning at the national level. The squad has done an outstanding job representing Stillwater at the state level and the State of Oklahoma at the national level; and

WHEREAS, the Stillwater High School Varsity Cheerleaders will be visiting the Oklahoma State Capitol on Tuesday, February 15, 2000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate recognizes the Stillwater High School Varsity Cheerleaders for their athletic and academic achievements.
