8 An Act relating to public health; directing the  
9 preparation and submission of certain state plan  
10 related to critical access hospitals; directing  
11 consultation with certain parties; providing for  
12 codification; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-706.6 of Title 63, unless  
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The State Department of Health shall prepare and submit a  
18 rural health care plan for the designation of critical access  
19 hospitals in accordance with the requirements of the federal  
20 Medicare Rural Hospital Flexibility Program.

21 B. The Department shall ensure that preparation of the plan is  
22 completed in consultation with the State Office of Rural Health, the  
23 state hospital association, rural hospitals, and the Legislative and  
24 Executive branches of the state, as well as representatives of  
25 medical or health care organizations within the state, as  
26 appropriate.

27 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
28 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
29 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
30 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
