HOUSE BILL NO. 1301

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; transferring the revenue enforcement section of the motor vehicle division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation; transferring certain employees, salaries, benefits and status; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 116.13a of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The powers, duties and responsibilities of the revenue enforcement section of the motor vehicle division of the Oklahoma Tax Commission are hereby transferred to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation. All employees of the section shall be transferred without any loss of salary, benefits, status or merit protection.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
