COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to environment and natural resources; amending 68 O.S. 1991, Section 53002, as renumbered by Section 359, Chapter 145, O.S.L. 1993, and as last amended by Section 11, Chapter 314, O.S.L. 1998 (27A O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 2-11-402), which relates to the Oklahoma Waste Tire Recycling Act; modifying and adding definitions; providing qualifications for certain definition; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 1991, Section 53002, as renumbered by Section 359, Chapter 145, O.S.L. 1993, and as last amended by Section 11, Chapter 314, O.S.L. 1998 (27A O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 2-11-402), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-11-402. As used in the Oklahoma Waste Tire Recycling Act:

1. "Department" means the Department of Environmental Quality;
2. "Priority cleanup list" means a list of unpermitted waste

dumps which:

- a. did not exist when the owner took possession of the property where the tires are located, and were created without the consent of or benefit to the owner of the property, and
- b. such other tire dumps designated by the Department pursuant to Section 2-11-406 of this title.

In determining the priority cleanup list, distance from a recycling facility shall not be a factor in priority and pickup.

3. "Tire" means any solid or air-filled covering for motor vehicle wheels;

~~3.~~ 4. "Tire dealer" means any person engaged in the business of selling new and used tires to final consumers, not for resale; ~~and~~

~~4.~~ 5. "Waste tire facility" means any place which is permitted as a solid waste disposal site, in accordance with the Oklahoma Solid Waste Management Act, at which waste tires are collected or deposited for processing by shredding or other technology, except baling, which alters the form of at least one-half of the tires collected, for the purpose of facilitating the future extraction of useful materials for recycling, reuse or energy recovery~~;~~ and

~~5.~~ 6. "Waste tire processing" means the preparation of waste tires to facilitate use for recycling, reuse or energy recovery.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
