8 An Act relating to sheriffs; amending 19 O.S. 1991,
9 Section 510, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 181,
10 O.S.L. 1992 (19 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 510), which
11 relates to county sheriff qualifications; modifying
12 training requirements for sheriffs; and providing an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 1991, Section 510, as
16 amended by Section 4, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 1992 (19 O.S. Supp. 1998,
17 Section 510), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 510. Any person, otherwise qualified, who has been a
19 resident of the State of Oklahoma for two (2) years, has been a
20 registered voter of the party whose nomination he seeks, or a
21 registered Independent, within the county from which such person
22 seeks election for the six (6) months next preceding the first day
23 of the filing period, is at least twenty-five (25) years of age next
24 preceding the date of filing for office, possesses at least a high
25 school education, shall be eligible to hold the office of county
26 sheriff or to file therefor. ~~Persons elected to the office of~~
27 ~~sheriff in a county of eighty thousand (80,000) or more population~~
28 ~~shall have one (1) year to complete a basic police course of that~~
29 ~~number of hours required of all other C.L.E.E.T. certified officers~~
30 ~~that has been approved by the Council on Law Enforcement Education~~
31 ~~and Training~~ Within twelve (12) months of taking office, all newly
32 elected or appointed sheriffs shall complete a sheriff's

1 administrative school which has been developed by the Oklahoma
2 Sheriff's Association and which has been approved by the Council on
3 Law Enforcement Education and Training. Provided, however, the
4 provisions of this section relating to qualifications shall not
5 apply to any person serving as a county sheriff or to any person
6 previously serving as county sheriff prior to the adoption of this
7 statute.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
