7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to schools; authorizing district
9 boards of education to provide for the voluntary
10 reciting of the Child's Daily Conduct Pledge; stating
11 pledge; providing for codification; providing an
12 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-106a of Title 70, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 School districts are authorized to provide a policy for schools
18 to allow the voluntary reciting of a Daily Conduct Pledge as
19 follows:

20 Daily Conduct Pledge

21 I will be respectful at all times;

22 I will be obedient unless asked to do wrong;

23 I will not hurt another person with my words or my acts, because
24 it is wrong to hurt others;

25 I will tell the truth, because it is wrong to tell a lie;

26 I will not steal, because it is wrong to take someone else's
27 property;

28 I will respect my body, and not take drugs;

29 I will show strength and courage, and not do something wrong,
30 just because others are doing it;

31 I pledge to be nonviolent and to respect my teachers and fellow
32 classmates.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
