House Bill No. 2632

As Amended

HOUSE BILL NO. 2632 -- By THORNBRUGH of the House and LONG of the Senate.

An Act relating to counties and county officers; authorizing county officers and employees to receive travel reimbursement and per diem in lieu of travel allowances; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 169 of Title 19, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In lieu of travel and expense reimbursement and travel allowances allowed by law for county officers and employees, county officers and employees **MAY** be allowed travel reimbursement and per diem pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
