ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1069 - By: THOMAS and SMITH (Dale) of the House and MICKLE and MORGAN of the Senate.

An Act relating to schools; declaring certain property to be property of Murray State College; requiring transfer of property under certain circumstances; and providing for codification.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3407.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The following described state property shall be the property of Murray State College:

Four acres of land out of the S1/2 of SW1/4 of NE1/4 of Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 6 East, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the West line of Murray Avenue of Murray College Addition to the Town of Tishomingo, Oklahoma, where said Avenue crosses or intersects the North line of that tract belonging to the State of Oklahoma as the site for the Murray State School of Agriculture, and extending South a distance of 210 feet; thence West 420 feet; thence North 210 feet; thence East 420 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2 acres, more or less.

1 Also a tract of land described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at
2 a point on the East line of Murray Avenue of Murray College Addition
3 to the Town of Tishomingo, Oklahoma, where said Avenue crosses or
4 intersects the North line of that tract belonging to the State of
5 Oklahoma, as the site for the Murray State School of Agriculture,
6 and extending South a distance of 210 feet; thence East 420 feet;
7 thence North 210 feet; these (thence) West 420 feet to the point of
8 beginning, containing 2 acres, more or less,

9 and containing 4 acres, more or less, according to the United
10 States survey, in both of said tracts;

11 together with the two dormitories, the furniture therein and all
12 appurtenances thereunto belonging.

13 B. The Department of Central Services shall implement a
14 transfer from the State of Oklahoma to Murray State College of any
15 property described in subsection A of this section that, on the
16 effective date of this act, is not the property of Murray State
17 College.
