House Bill No. 2195

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2195 - By: HUTCHISON of the House and EASLEY of the Senate.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating the Cliff Bogle Memorial Highway; requiring the Department of Transportation to place markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1635 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 82, starting at the intersection of State Highway 82 and State Highway 20 in Mayes County extending approximately 15.0 miles to the intersection of State Highway 82 and U.S. Highway 66 in Craig County shall be designated as the "Cliff Bogle Memorial Highway". The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the name.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
