ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2593 - By: BRYANT, FERGUSON, GILBERT, BENGE, CALVEY, CASE, DEUTSCHENDORF, GREENWOOD, INGMIRE, JONES, LIOTTA, MILLER, NANCE, PETTIGREW, PHILLIPS, POPE (Tim), REESE, ROGGOW, SULLIVAN (Leonard), VAUGHN, WINCHESTER, WORTHEN and WRIGHT of the House and CAIN of the Senate.

An Act relating to public health and safety; requiring the State Board of Health and the Board of Pharmacy to develop program to redistribute unused prescription drugs; providing exception; requiring promulgation of rules; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-552 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Health and the Board of Pharmacy shall jointly develop a program consistent with public health and safety through which unused prescription drugs, other than prescription drugs defined as controlled dangerous substances by Section 2-101 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, may be transferred from nursing homes to repositories established for the purpose of distributing the medication to Oklahoma residents who are medically indigent.

1 B. The State Board of Health and the Board of Pharmacy shall
2 promulgate rules and establish procedures necessary and appropriate
3 to implement the provisions of subsection A of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
