5 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 568 - By: HORNER of the
6 Senate and ROSS of the House.

7 An Act relating to prisons and reformatories; authorizing
8 the Department of Corrections to dispose of certain real
9 property; requiring certain sale procedures; directing sale
10 proceeds be deposited in certain fund; providing for
11 noncodification.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 The Department of Corrections is hereby authorized to dispose of
16 the real property known as the Tulsa Community Corrections Center,
17 in the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, the legal
18 description of which is as follows:

19 All of Block 201 of original town of Tulsa, now City of Tulsa,
20 Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, according to the plat filed of
21 record in the Office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County on March
22 19, 1909, and all of Lot 7 in Block 201 in Woodlawn Addition, an
23 addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,
24 according to the plats filed of record in the Office of the County
25 Clerk of Tulsa County on July 11, 1908, and March 19, 1909, which
26 warranty deed was duly recorded May 19, 1983, in Block 4692 at 1031-

1 1033, inclusive in the Office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County,
2 Oklahoma.

3 Such property shall be disposed of pursuant to the provisions of
4 Section 129.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes provided,
5 notwithstanding any other provision of law, all monies received from
6 the sale or disposition of said property, except those monies
7 necessary to pay the expenses incurred pursuant to such sale, shall
8 be deposited into the Department of Corrections Revolving Fund for
9 the purpose of construction to the Central Office or for the
10 purchase of a building to be used by the Central Office. Upon the
11 sale of said property the Department of Corrections shall notify the
12 Legislature and the listing of said property in paragraph C of
13 Section 502 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes as part of the
14 definition of institutions and the listing of said property in
15 Section 509 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes as official state
16 penal institutions shall be properly amended to delete said property
17 from the properties of this state used as penal institutions.
