

An Act relating to law enforcement vehicles; making declaration of danger to public health and safety; prohibiting use by municipal police departments of unmarked cars for routine traffic enforcement; stating exceptions; amending 19 O.S. 1991, Section 180.43, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 91, O.S.L. 1994 (19 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 180.43), which relates to automobiles used by sheriffs; making declaration of danger to public health and safety; prohibiting use of unmarked cars for routine traffic enforcement; stating exceptions; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 12-218, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 55, O.S.L. 1998 (47 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 12-218), which relates to audible and visible signals on vehicles; providing description of lights to be used on certain unmarked vehicles; amending 21 O.S. 1991, Section 1533, as last amended by Section 8, Chapter 2, 1st Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1998 (21 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 1533), which relates to falsely personating certain persons; modifying means of falsely personating a law enforcement officer; modifying penalty; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
