

An Act relating to managed care plans; requiring managed care plans to make certain referrals under certain circumstances; directing certain persons be authorized as primary care providers under certain circumstances; directing authorization for nonformulary prescriptions under certain circumstances; directing managed care plans to take certain action to ensure continuity of care when a provider is terminated or a new covered person is enrolled; establishing conditions; providing for coverage for clinical trials under certain circumstances; creating the Managed Health Care Accountability Act; defining terms; requiring exercise of ordinary care when making health care treatment decisions; making managed care entities liable for damage for harm to enrollees caused by health care treatment decisions; providing clarifications; making certain clauses void; prohibiting certain defenses; requiring certain actions; providing for effect of certain allegations; providing for construction of section; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
