

An Act relating to schools; allowing district boards of education to issue a certificate of distinction; providing certain qualifications for a certificate of distinction; authorizing the application of certain vocational-technical courses and advanced placement courses toward qualifications for a certificate of distinction; defining terms; prohibiting colleges and universities from requiring a certificate of distinction for admission; repealing Section 1, Chapter 251, O.S.L. 1998, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 320, O.S.L. 1999 and Section 2, Chapter 251, O.S.L. 1998, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 320, O.S.L. 1999 (70 O.S. Supp. 1999, Sections 11-103.2c and 11-103.2d), which relate to the diploma of honor; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
