

An Act relating to sex offenders; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 991a, as last amended by Section 1 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1046 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to sentencing powers of the court; authorizing polygraph testing of sex offenders under certain circumstances; amending 51 O.S. 1991, Section 24A.8, which relates to law enforcement records; removing restriction on making sex offender information available; amending 57 O.S. 1991, Sections 583, 584 and 585, as last amended by Sections 2, 3 and 4, Chapter 336, O.S.L. 1999 (57 O.S. Supp. 1999, Sections 583, 584 and 585), which relate to sex offender registration; specifying types of probationary terms which shall require registration as sex offender; adding procedure concerning new addresses for sex offenders; requiring local law enforcement agency to make its sex offender registry available without restriction upon request; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 991c, as last amended by Section 5 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2711 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to deferral of sentencing; specifying sex offenses which are not eligible for sentence deferral; eliminating exception; repealing 22 O.S. 1991, Section 991a, as last amended by Section 3 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2209 of the 2nd Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to sentencing powers of the court; and providing an effective date.
