

An Act relating to confinement officers; providing short title; defining terms; stating eligibility requirements for certification of confinement officers; requiring completion of psychological evaluation prior to certification; requiring employing agency to provide certain information on reports; requiring proof of high school diploma or GED certificate for certain persons; providing certain exemptions for certain persons; prohibiting persons participating in deferred sentence from being certified as confinement officers; requiring confinement officers to be fingerprinted; authorizing release of certain information to employing agencies; providing for release of liability; providing certain reports to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training; establishing criteria for revocation of certification; establishing criteria for suspension of certification; providing forms for certain complaints; authorizing investigation of complaints; providing for certain proceedings; specifying number of training hours required for certification; stating employment requirements for persons not certified as confinement officers; providing for extensions of time requirement; providing for certification for persons who have completed other course of study; specifying powers and duties of the Council; specifying continuing number of training hours required annually; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
