

An Act relating to workers' compensation; amending 85 O.S. 1991, Sections 3, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 361, O.S.L. 1997, Section 24, Chapter 1, 2nd Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1994, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 353, O.S.L. 1998, 16, as last amended by Section 7, Chapter 361, O.S.L. 1997, 22, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 420, O.S.L. 1999, and 24.2, as last amended by Section 10, Chapter 361, O.S.L. 1997 (85 O.S. Supp. 1999, Sections 3, 14.2, 16, 22 and 24.2), which relate to the Workers' Compensation Act, definitions, certified workplace medical plans, rehabilitation and job placement, compensation, and notices of injury to the employer; defining term; modifying definition; clarifying rights to treatment and rights of physicians outside of certified workplace medical plans; deleting limitation on certain benefits during retraining or job placement program; requiring payment of attorney fee if certain benefits are not voluntarily provided; increasing limit of benefits for temporary partial disability; requiring employer and employer's insurer to deal fairly and in good faith; and providing an effective date.
