

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; amending Section 14, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 1995, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 286, O.S.L. 1998 (21 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 1290.14), which relates to firearms instructors; providing for extended CLEET approval; amending 21 O.S. 1991, Section 1277, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 191, O.S.L. 1996 (21 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 1277), which relates to places of unlawful carry; construing authority to carry in certain places; amending 21 O.S. 1991, Section 1289.23, as last amended by Section 8, Chapter 191, O.S.L. 1996 (21 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 1289.23), which relates to off-duty peace officers; construing certain authority to carry concealed handgun; providing option for off-duty peace officer to carry concealed handgun under the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; amending Section 10, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 1995, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 358, O.S.L. 1997, Section 11, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 1995, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 415, O.S.L. 1999, Section 12, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 1995, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 415, O.S.L. 1999, Section 24, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 1995, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 415, O.S.L. 1999, and Section 25, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 1995 (21 O.S. Supp. 1999, Sections 1290.10, 1290.11, 1290.12, 1290.24 and 1290.25), which relate to mandatory preclusions, other preclusions, procedure for application, immunity, and legislative intent; providing additional preclusions; making involuntary commitment a permanent preclusion; modifying certain preclusive period; clarifying certain term; expanding immunity provision; granting certain immunity for firearms instructors; expanding legislative intent; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 18, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 397, O.S.L. 1997 (22 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 18), which relates to expungement of criminal records; providing additional classes of persons authorized to file motion for expungement; amending 10 O.S. 1991, Section 20, which relates to parental and child liability; providing for exception; amending 23 O.S. 1991, Section 10, which relates to damages; authorizing civil damages for certain criminal conduct; amending Section 4, Chapter 325, O.S.L. 1993, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 357, O.S.L. 1997 (21 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 142B), which relates to civil damages; removing requirement for uninsured claim; amending 21 O.S. 1991, Section 1273, as last amended by Section 29, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 1995 (21 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 1273), which relates to minors possessing firearms; providing reference for certain damages; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
