

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 1175.1, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 207, O.S.L. 1992, 1175.2, 1175.3, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 407, O.S.L. 1997, 1175.4, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 161, O.S.L. 1996, 1175.5, 1175.6, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 407, O.S.L. 1997, and 1175.7, as amended by Section 7, Chapter 407, O.S.L. 1997 (22 O.S. Supp. 1999, Sections 1175.1, 1175.3, 1175.4, 1175.6 and 1175.7), which relate to determination of competency procedure; modifying definition; making references gender neutral; modifying who may raise question of incompetency; providing for examination by qualified forensic examiners; providing for outpatient examination to be conducted in specified locales; providing for committing of person to the custody of specified entities; providing for notification of court under certain circumstances; providing for payment of costs of maintaining specified person in certain facility; providing time frame for hearing to determine competency; requiring determination to include consideration of specified report; allowing testimony by certain transmission under certain circumstances; clarifying language; modifying provisions related to disposition orders and placement in maximum security mental ward; limiting conditions under which a person may be committed; and providing an effective date.
