AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to tobacco; providing that monies received from tobacco lawsuit settlement be allocated to State Treasurer; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.15 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All monies received by the State of Oklahoma pursuant to any settlement with or judgment against any tobacco company or companies shall be placed in the State Treasury in a fund to be known as the State Tobacco Lawsuit Fund and shall be subject to appropriation by the Legislature for any lawful purpose.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
