HOUSE BILL HB1956

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; directing the State Department of Health and the Board of Pharmacy to establish a program for the distribution of unused pharmaceuticals to medically indigent persons; specifying certain requirements for the program; directing the promulgation of certain rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-554 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Health and the Board of Pharmacy shall jointly implement a program for the distribution of unused pharmaceuticals from the residents of nursing homes, skilled nursing facilities, and similar facilities, to medically indigent persons. The pharmaceuticals shall be distributed through programs administered by county and city-county health departments. The State Board of Health and the Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate rules and establish procedures as necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
